### **Body Regions**

#### Head and Neck

cephalic	head

gluteal	buttocks
perineal	between anus and genitals

### <u>Upper Limbs</u>

brachial	upper arm
antecubital	elbow "pit"
cubital	elbow
antebrachial	lower arm
carpal	wrist
palmar	palm
digital	fingers

#### Lower Limbs

femoral	upper leg
patellar	knee
popliteal	knee "pit"
crural	lower leg
tarsal	ankle
pedal	top of foot
plantar	sole of foot
digital	toes

## **Relative Positions**

medial	closer to the midpoint
lateral	to the side of
proximal	closer to the point of attachment
distal	farther from the point of attachment
superior	above / higher on the body
inferior	below / lower on the body
anterior (ventral)	on the front / toward the front / in front of
posterior (dorsal)	on the back / toward the back / behind
superficial	closer to the surface / on the surface
deep	below the surface / interior

# **<u>3 Types of Planes</u>**

transverse plane	divides a body part horizontally (superior and inferior parts)
coronal plane	divides a body part into anterior and posterior parts
sagittal plane	divides a body part vertically (lateral parts)
